## Items that are not permitted

Jeans of any colour
Mini skirts
Leggings
Hats
Ripped or torn clothing
Strappy or revealing tops
Sportswear (including trainers or 'hoodies')
Shorts
Flip- flops

If we feel that a student is inappropriately dressed we will require the student to return home and change her/his clothes before returning to school. Students should not underestimate the part that appearance plays in both their personal and professional development; thereby demonstrating their commitment to the school by following this dress code. If any student is unsure whether an item of clothing is permitted, they should bring the item with them to school and check with the Head of Secondary/Sixth Form before they wear it during the school day.

In all cases, on matters relating to the dress code, the judgement of senior members of staff is final.
