

Sixth Form Code of Conduct

The Student Code of Conduct sets out the school's expectations in relation to student behaviour at school and when representing the school in the local, national and international community.

The Sixth Form Code of Conduct has been written in negotiation with our Student Council.

All Year 12, 13 and Bachillerato students must familiarise themselves with the code and adhere to the following expectations.

Students must act as a positive role model for each other and towards members of the public.

Students must behave with courtesy and consideration at all times.

Students must have respect for all members of the school and the wider community regardless of their culture, background, sexuality or ethnicity.

Students must respect the property of other members of the school community.

Students should not bring banned substances into school for their use or for the use by others. This will result in permanent exclusion.

Students must take responsibility for their actions.

It is recommended that students keep mobile phones in their locker/bag for safe keeping. The school can take no responsibility if a mobile phone is lost or used by another student.

Students must attend school regularly, on time and aim for 100% attendance.

If you know in advance that you will be absent (e.g. medical appointment, interview, open days etc.) you must inform your Form Tutor and subject teachers, making arrangements to complete any work missed.

We also expect students:

To complete all preparation and research, including any reading, prior to lessons when requested by subject teachers.

To meet deadlines and communicate effectively with subject teachers should conflicting deadlines arise.

To use study periods effectively.

To abide by the Sixth Form Dress Code at all times.

Sixth Form Study area and Common Room - Code of Conduct

Year 12 and 13 students are responsible for ensuring the Sixth Form Study area and Common room are kept clean and tidy.

Both rooms should be used carefully, safely and respectfully. You should behave quietly and sensibly. Students must not sit on desks or the floor anywhere around the school. Please place the chairs under the tables before leaving these rooms.

Students will ensure their own rubbish is placed in the bins provided and any furniture which has been moved will be returned to its original place.

All bags must be placed on the shelves provided.

Hot drinks must not be taken outside of the Study area. Please clean up any spills.

Card games must not be played during study periods.

Notices must not be posted or removed from the noticeboard without the permission of the Head of Sixth Form.

Mobile devices and headphones may be used in the Study area and Common Room, at all times. They may also be used in the red and green pitches during break and lunchtime.

Music must be inaudible to other Study area or Common Room users.
