E: Environment: Do you take care of the school building, lunch hall, playgrounds?

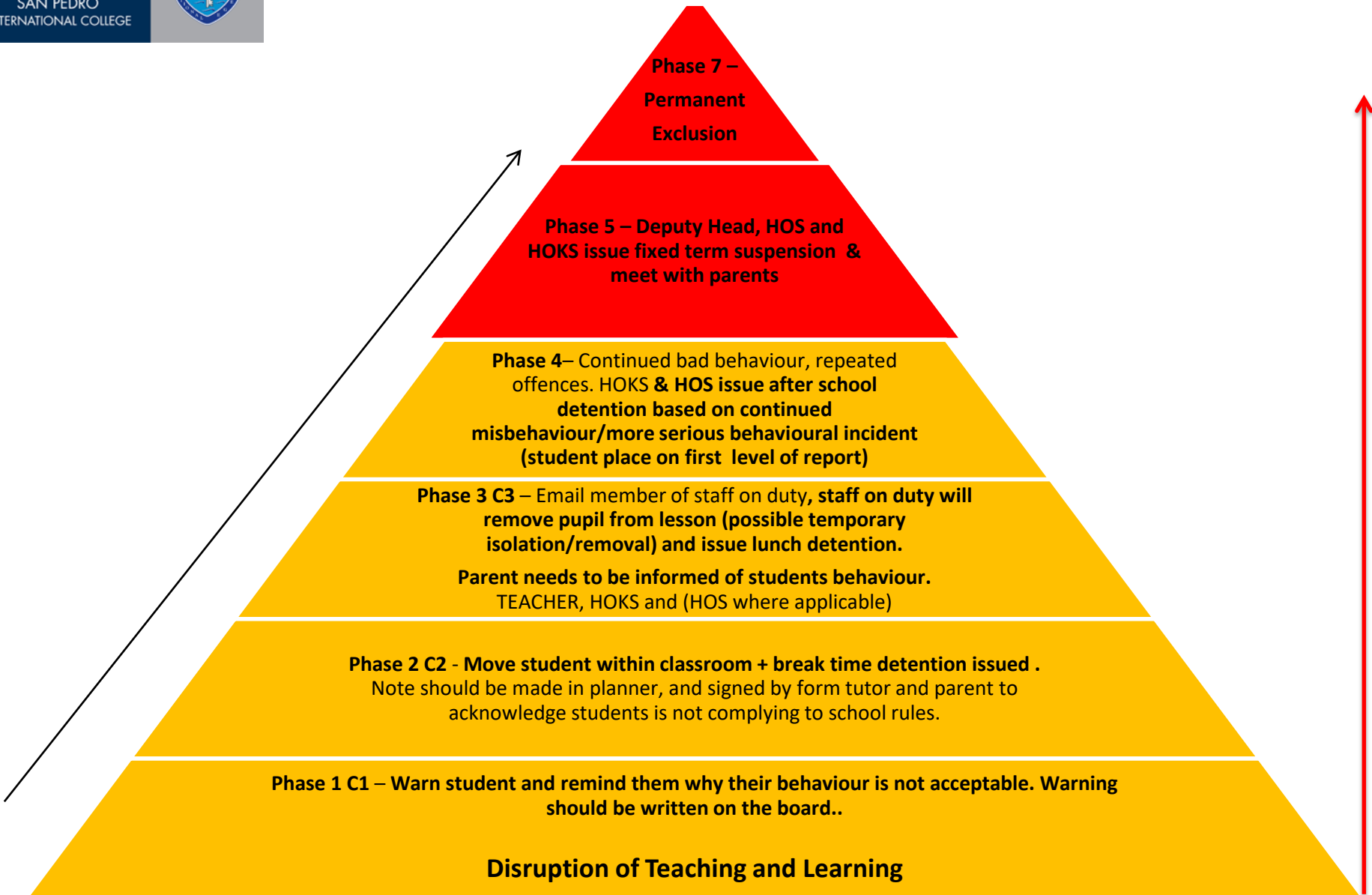
C: Choices: Do you make the right ones? Are you going to be a role model for others?

Reward System - It is expected that all good work and demonstration of good behaviour will be rewarded with a House Merit. A **maximum of 3 merits per student per lesson.**
