

Enrichment Programme - Year 12, 13 and Bachillerato

We recognise that work experience and community service is a very important aspect of positive career development and constantly encourage our students to develop their experiences during their time at Laude.

Enrichment service can be completed in a variety of ways at our school. Year 12, 13 and Bachillerato students are encouraged to complete at least 20 periods of enrichment service during each academic year in order to obtain a certificate of achievement. Universities and prospective employers value this type of voluntary work experience.

Students attend at least one lesson every week for their chosen subject and help younger students as directed by the subject teacher. They have the opportunity to help in a different subject every 6 weeks.

Subject	Experience offered
Science	Acting as learning or language assistants during Yr7/8 Science lessons
Humanities	Providing extra support for Yr7 and 8 history/geography students
Food Technology	Helping younger students providing language support
Primary / KS1	Reading with students in Year 1 and Year 2. Helping in the dining hall.
Mixed Media	Assisting children with filming, recording of instruments and vocals and using programmes such as photoshop, garageband and iMovie
Modern Foreign Languages	Supporting French/German/Spanish learners with their listening reading and speaking skills.
Induction	Supporting EAL students with their reading and public speaking presentation skills.
Library	Reading to younger children and general administration.

ICT	Assisting Year 7 students in developing software skills.
PE	Helping younger students develop their physical skills. Helping with everyday running of our department.
Art & Design	Helping out in the Art room with younger children and general organisation.
Local Charities ADANA	These can be completed in the evenings, weekends and during school holidays. Local charities are always looking for volunteers to help out. Get in contact and offer some free time and pick up valuable life skills.
Matemáticas	Helping students to improve their mathematical skills working in small groups.
Educación Artística	Any students who want to study engineering or architecture at university are welcome to join us.
