1 – Motivational Mathematics



Year 8 Maths: Many students initially find it difficult to understand the concept of the locus of a point which obeys a certain rule. To

overcome this, we took learning outside the classroom. In the picture, two students represented points A and B. The rest of the students were asked to stand so they were equidistant from A and B. As they all rushed to stand in the centre of the imaginary line joining A and B, they realised they needed to stand on the perpendicular bisector. All students enjoyed a more practical approach to the subject – especially on a warm, sunny day!

Students from **Year 7 and 8 and 1ESO and 2ESO** participated this week in a *Gifted and Talented* workshop focused on Decision-Making skills. They had to make the tough decision: to risk or reward. In a travel-inspired board game, students worked on a tight budget to make their way

to the end point, facing a series of obstacles along the way. In the next few weeks, they will design their own games with the objective of testing their peers’ decision-making skills.
